Young Entrepreneur's Club

The Young Entrepreneur's Club is a group of Year 6 and Year 8 students who meet twice a week to learn more about what it takes to come up with good business ideas and to execute these ideas successfully.

As part of this initiative, students have to come up with a small business venture that they can manage and run themselves for a short period of time in order to give them some experience of retail and commerce.

This is the second phase of the project and students are now using the lessons learned from the "What Went Well" and "Even Better If" exercise conducted after the first phase. This has enabled them to implement possible solutions to issues raised previously.

To this end, the Young Entrepreneur's Club will be selling some hand-made Easter themed items during lunch time in the School Foyer on **Thursday 30 and Friday 31 of March 2017**.

The group will also be hosting an Easter themed treasure hunt called the "mEGGa Hunt" on **Wednesday 5 April 2017**. Tickets for the mEGGa Hunt will be sold at £1 each and the sale of Easter themed products will vary in price from 20p to £1.50.

Profits will be re-invested into the next phase of the challenge and a proportion will be donated to charity and school facilities.

Posters will be around the school to promote the initiative to students and to remind them to bring their money in to school to avoid disappointment.
